Steph has a new role at *Inclusive Sport SA!*

The Transition Project was a two year funded program with the aim of

'Assisting individuals transition into mainstream opportunities in sport and recreation'.

During the project, it was found that although we could provide support to individuals to transition into sports, some did not have an environment that was inclusive of all audiences who wanted to access sport and recreation– *this is where the development of an* Inclusion Advisor role was created!

As of July, Steph will be working with State Sporting Organisations and sport and recreation clubs to examine their inclusive practices and if they are currently delivering best practice for inclusion within their communities. With the current rollout of the NDIS clubs are considering the impact this has for families and their desires for 'normality' for their children in sport and recreation.
